Item Description: Two (2) of eleven (11) greenish blue stones set in a white metal bracelet with numerous near-colorless round and pear brilliants.

Weight: 56.30 grams (gross)

Measurements: 14.52 x 8.49 x 6.12 mm and 14.93 x 11.04 x 6.16 mm

Comments: These copper and manganese bearing tourmalines may be called "paraíba tourmaline" in the trade. The name "paraíba" comes from the Brazilian locality where this gem was first mined, however today it may come from several localities.
Only two (2) of the largest greenish blue stones were selected for testing.
Any statement on geographic origin is an expert opinion based on a collection of observations and analytical data.
